



The Economic Value of Parks: NYC

The Trust for Public Land relied on ArcGIS Business Analyst to analyze the billions of dollars in benefits and savings that New York City parks give residents, businesses, and visitors each year, such as the \$9.1 billion in recreational value, \$2.43 billion in avoided stormwater treatment costs, and \$17.9 billion in tourism spending generated by the parks.


